What are we learning about?

In this unit of work we are going to learn about Collagraph Printing.



Why are we learning about it?

We are learning about collagraph printing because artists use a wide range of printing techniques to create artworks. We are starting with collagraph printing because it is a quick and experimental type of printing.



What new KNOWLEDGE will I gain?

You will learn:

- 1 new key word: Texture.
- How a collagraph is made and printed.
- How to recognize a type of art called a Collagraph and why artists use printmaking methods.



TOPIC: Portraiture - Collagraph Printing

How does this build on the SKILLS I already have?

During your portraiture project, you learnt how to draw shape and proportion from a photograph. During this project you will develop this skill to design an artwork for your collagraph print.



What new SKILLS will I develop?

You will develop skills in:

- Simplifying drawings and designing a collagraph.
- Tracing and collage techniques to make a collagraph.
- Collagraph printing.



How does this build on the KNOWLEDGE I already have?

You have learnt about shape in your portraiture project, this project will develop your understanding of shape and how to simplify shapes. You have learnt about tone in your portraiture project, this will develop your knowledge of the different ways in which tone can be created in art.
