What are we learning about?

In the Listening and Appraising component you will be assessed on your knowledge and understanding of the Areas of Study. This term we will be learning about Area Study 4: Film Music through the key musical elements, contexts and language.



Why are we learning about it?

We want to encourage you to be creative and to broaden your musical understanding with Areas of Study that inspire and challenge. To recognise contrasting genres, styles and traditions of music, and develop some awareness of musical chronology.



What new KNOWLEDGE will I gain?

You will study a range of techniques that are used in different types of Film Music and names of Film and Video Game Music composers. Including music that has been composed specifically for a film, Western Classical music that has been used in a film and music that has been composed for a video game

How does this build on the KNOWLEDGE I already have?

This further builds on your knowledge and understanding of the musical elements and compositional devices by exploring how composers use music dramatically and expressively.
