What are we learning about?

This half term, you will start to learn how to describe what you do and don't have, as well as giving basic descriptions and opinions.



Why are we learning about it?

Being able to use nouns and adjectives in a sentence in French is the first building block in working towards fluency. Giving your opinion in French is essential in building towards giving your points of view.



What new KNOWLEDGE will I gain?

- Vocabulary for stationery items
- The phrases 'il y a' and 'il n'y a pas de'
- The four basic opinion phrases j'adore, j'aime, je n'aime pas and je déteste
- Colours and how to use adjectives in French sentences



TOPIC: J'aime mon stylo vert! (I like my green pen!)

How does this build on the SKILLS I already have?

Last half term you learned stock phrases and how to change elements of them to make them about yourself. The skills you will learn this half term will give you the tools to start expressing yourself more independently in French.



What new SKILLS will I develop?

- You will start to learn the basics of French grammar, such as articles and adjective endings.
- You will start to extend your sentences to include more than one clause in both speaking and writing.



How does this build on the KNOWLEDGE I already have?

Last half term, you learned the basics of French, such as sounds, numbers and the alphabet. This new learning will allow you to start to formulate your own more detailed sentences.
