- You will learn to use direct object pronouns to talk about a 3<sup>rd</sup> person.



### How does this build on the KNOWLEDGE I already have?

In year 7, you learned how to describe your personality. This half term you will expand on this by learning new adjectives and using them to describe someone else in detail. In year 8 you learned how to make basic invitations to go out; this half term you will expand on this to make detailed plans.
