How does this build on the

What new **SKILLS** will I <u>develop?</u> - You will learn to use the

conditional tense to give reasons for why you want to do something in the future.



How does this build on the KNOWLEDGE I already have? You have learned hundreds of nouns by this point in year 9; what you have not yet experienced is nouns that can be either masculine or feminine. This topic will be your first contact with this type of noun in French.
