What are we learning about?

Evaluating different play activities for a chosen developmental area.



Why are we learning about it?

This will form the final and largest part of the coursework. In a vocational setting, practitioners would need a thorough understanding of how to evaluate an activity, in terms of the norms development of the child.



What new **KNOWLEDGE** will I gain?

You will learn how to write a detailed observation of the activity that the child has carried out. You will learn how to link this back to developmental norms.

What new **SKILLS** will I develop?

You will develop observation and recording skills. You will also learn how to evaluate an activity and plan to enhance a child's development further.

The evaluation of the norms development of the child will build on the knowledge that you gained during RO20 LO1, you will be putting this research into practise.
