- To compare different viewpoints that are held within the UK with your own viewpoint on a variety of issues.



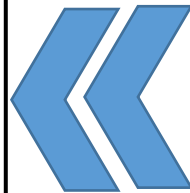
What new **KNOWLEDGE** will I gain?

- How family life is changing in 21<sup>st</sup> Century Britain.



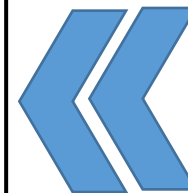
How does this build on the **SKILLS** I already have?
