- To consider why Christians choose to live by the values of Jesus in the twenty-first century.



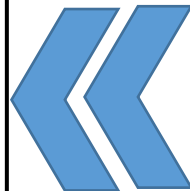
What new **KNOWLEDGE** will I gain?

- The presence of Christianity in the world



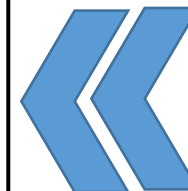
How does this build on the **SKILLS** I already have?
