What are we learning about?

Why are we learning about it?

- Death is an issue that we will all have to experience at some point.
- Religious beliefs and teachings can help give comfort and support around the issue of death.
- Beliefs about death and dying can impact the way that a person lives their life.



What new **KNOWLEDGE** will I gain?

- An understanding of the different reasons why some non-religious people believe in an afterlife.
- An understanding of the differences between western and eastern beliefs about death.
- An understanding of different attitudes towards death: from sadness and suffering to celebration and remembrance.



How does this build on the **SKILLS** I already have?

- Independently using religious texts to answer questions (Reference to Scripture)
- Being able to explain your own opinion without the teacher's help (Judgement).
- Explain how religious beliefs help to influence believers to do certain things (Explain/ Influence).



What new **SKILLS** will I develop?

- Being able to compare and contrast religious and nonreligious points of view (compare & contrast).
- Debate individual responses to the issue of death and the afterlife (Influence).
- Come to your own conclusion about what happens when you die and if it matters (Judgement).



How does this build on the **KNOWLEDGE** I already have?

After looking at each different religion on its own, we are now using this knowledge and applying it to the issue of death and the afterlife.
