

HT1 TOPIC: Yr10 Urban Issues and Challenges (urbanisation and Rio)

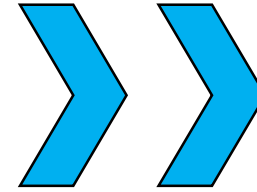
What are we learning about?

You will learn about how the growth of Rio has created many opportunities for the people of Rio and Brazil, but, also how it has created many challenges and how they are trying to overcome those challenges.



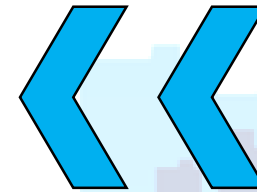
How does this build on the SKILLS I already have?
