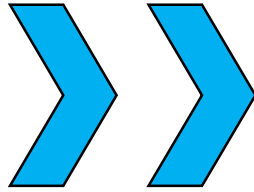


HT4 TOPIC: Yr10 Natural Hazards (hurricanes and climate change)

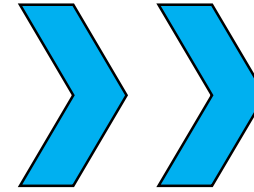
What are we learning about?

You will learn about the cause, effects and responses to hurricanes by focusing on an example (Typhoon Haiyan). You will learn about the causes, effects and responses to climate change.



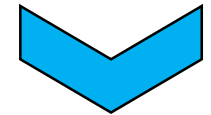
Why are we learning about it?

Climate change has been described as the greatest threat that humans face and its effects will alter the lives of millions if not billions of people. One of the biggest impacts will be the increasing number and power of storms in particular hurricanes.



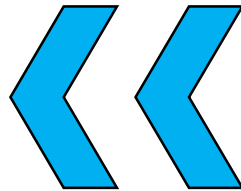
What new KNOWLEDGE will I gain?

You will learn about the impacts and possible solutions to climate change. You will learn about Typhoon Haiyan in detail including the effects and responses to the storm.



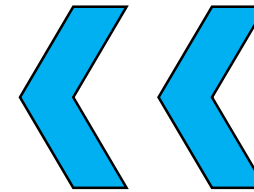
How does this build on the SKILLS I already have?

You will build on the complex skills of evaluating and assessing e.g. assess the impact of short term responses to a hurricane you have studied. You will also build on the less complex but equally important skills such as inference e.g. suggest a short term impact of a hurricane from the photo.



What new SKILLS will I develop?

In this unit you will need to focus on seeing the “bigger picture” in terms of how small individual actions can be both the cause and solution to climate change.



How does this build on the KNOWLEDGE I already have?

In Year 7 you learnt about extreme weather and climate change, this unit builds on that knowledge and adds more specific detail to the knowledge that already have on the subject.
