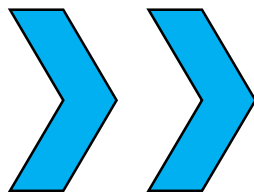


HT5 TOPIC: Yr10 Changing Economic World (Development)

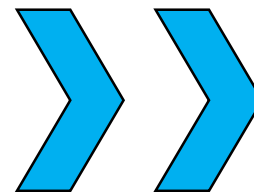
What are we learning about?

You will learn how development can be measured and compared. You will learn why some countries are more developed and some are less developed and how Fair Trade and Tourism can reduce the development gap.



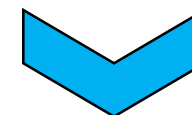
Why are we learning about it?

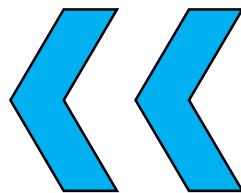
What new KNOWLEDGE will I gain?

You will learn about population pyramids and the Demographic Transition Model and the links between them. You will also learn about the problems that both rich and poor countries face due to the changes in their populations.



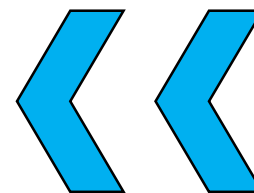
How does this build on the SKILLS I already have?
