You will learn about what are essential resources. You will learn about the inequality in the supply and consumption of resources globally. You will learn about the main issues surrounding food, water and energy in the UK.




Why are we learning about it?


What new KNOWLEDGE will I gain?

You will learn about how our government makes sure that the population has enough resources and how we can move from energy produced by fossil fuels to a more sustainable energy mix including renewable sources.




How does this build on the SKILLS I already have?
