Climate Change is a "hot topic", and controlling it is vital. By understanding what it is, what causes it, and how we stop it, we can be better prepare for a more sustainable future.


What new KNOWLEDGE will I

You can already read weather pressure charts of the UK, and you will build on this in a global context.


You can already work with others who have similar opinions, and you can discuss your ideas with them.
