Learning Journey

What are we learning about?

This half term, you will learn to discuss what you and other people are like, your family and friends, and who your model(s) is/are.



Why are we learning about it?

Being able to give detailed description of yourself and your relationships with others is an important step in becoming more confident and fluent in French.



What new KNOWLEDGE will I gain?

- Expanded vocabulary for describing yourself and other people (Physical appearance and personality)
- Reflexive verb phrases to describe how you get on with people

TOPIC: Qui suis-je? (Who am I?)



How does this build on the SKILLS I already have?

In KS3, you learned the 3 tenses separately. We will build on this to ensure that you are comfortable using all 3 tenses in the same piece of work (an essential skill for GCSE Writing and Speaking).



What new SKILLS will I develop?

- You will practice using 3 tenses together (perfect, present and near future).
- You will learn the basics of a new past tense: the imperfect.



How does this build on the KNOWLEDGE I already have?

At KS3, you learned to describe yourself and other people in a simple way; this half term, we will expand your grammar and vocabulary so that you are able to do this in much more depth, including using 'Higher-tier' phrases.
