What are we learning about?

We are returning to our strand of 'Keeping Safe' by considering dangerous issues to do with sexual relationships. We will identify key warning signs and consider strategies of supporting someone in a dangerous situation.



Why are we learning about it?

You need to know the warning signs of dangerous issues like Child Sexual Exploitation to be able to report it, to potentially save a life. Furthermore, controlling relationships and harassment may change over time - you need to know the key features.
