What are we learning about?

In this unit of work we are going to learn about Colour and then link this back to last half-term by exploring portraiture in Pop Art.



Why are we learning about it?

We are learning about colour because it is important to understand how to mix and combine colours to create artworks. We will also explore press printing because it is a quick and experimental type of printing.



What new KNOWLEDGE will I gain? You will learn:

How to mix colours and the relationships between them.

- What is a tint and shade.
- What is Pop Art and how to follow press printmaking methods.



TOPIC: Portraiture - Colour/Pop Art Portraits

How does this build on the SKILLS I already have? During your portraiture project, you learnt how to draw shape and proportion from a photograph. During this project you will simplify images and explore colour and how to apply this by researching key artists.



What new SKILLS will I develop?

You will develop skills in:

- Painting and mixing colours.
- Simplifying images to design a press print.
- Experimenting with colour to create Pop Art style prints.



How does this build on the KNOWLEDGE I already have? You have learnt about shape in your portraiture project, this project will develop your understanding of shape and how to simplify shapes. You have learnt about tone in your portraiture project, this will develop your knowledge of creating tints and shades of a colour.
