TOPIC: Landscapes

How does this build on the SKILLS I already have?

You have already learnt skills in simplifying an image in Yr 7 (Pop Art Prints). You will now learn new techniques in hand manipulating felt and fabric, and sewing skills giving you the opportunity to build on your skills from Kente Cloth in Yr 7 learning how to create basic stitches.



What new SKILLS will I develop?

You will learn new techniques in manipulating felt and fabric, developing sewing and stitching skills. You will also explore dry felting as a means of adding textures/mark making in the style of David Hockney's work.



How does this build on the KNOWLEDGE I already have?

- Adding to your knowledge of History of Art and Artists.
- Building on Kente Cloth from Yr7 and expanding our knowledge of textiles.
