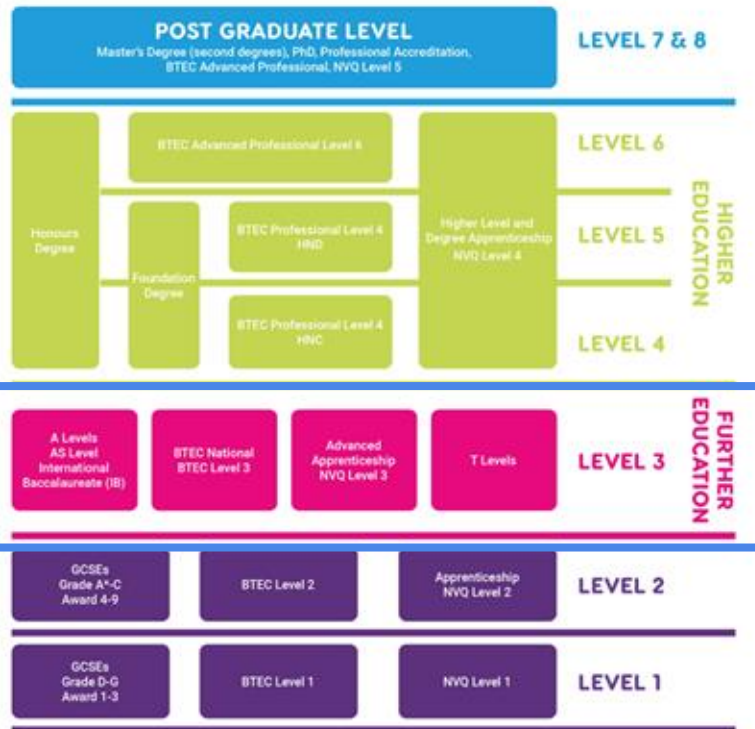

If you do not secure English Language & Maths, you **will** have to resit them, regardless of your Post-16 option.

- Equivalent to 3 A Levels, 2 year course;
- Approximately 45 day work experience placement;
- York College - 15 options, inc: Science, Marketing, Education & Early Years, Electrical Installation;
- Askham Bryan - 4 options, inc: Animal Management, Horticulture, Agriculture;
- Assessed through exams & a task from an employer;
- Graded: Pass, Merit, Distinction, Distinction*

Post-16 Options



- Vary in length from 6 months to 2 years;
- Often have to start at Level 2 to gain industry-relevant experience;
- Some involve 1 day a week at training provider (e.g YC / ABC / Derwent Training), others involve block placements at college;
- Very competitive - limited number of places;
- Minimum wage is £8 per hour;
- Require Eng/Maths, or you must resit during programme;

A Level

100%
classroom

- L3 course - usually, you take 3 subjects;
- Can involve some coursework, but largely assessed by linear exams (like GCSEs);
- York College, All Saints Sixth Form, Huntington Sixth Form, Fulford Sixth Form, Archbishop Holgate's Sixth Form, Joseph Rowntree
- Higher entry requirements - often at least 5 grade 5s, plus up to a grade 6 in the subject being studied
- **Cannot be completed without Grade 4 English Lang & Maths**

V Levels / BTECs

- BTECs - often classroom-based, with some hands-on experience. Over time, they are being phased out in favour of V Levels
- V Levels - starting September 2027 in Digital; Education & Early Years; Finance & Accounting
- Designed to be taken alongside A Levels - they will be equivalent to 1 A Level

- Universities (in general) accept all of these Post-16 qualifications;
- Start thinking about what you might be interested in studying;
